To E3 Africa Board of Directors,

When I became pastor of St James Parish in December of 2015, I took the first year to observe how the parish ran, became acquainted with the parishioners of the parish and took time for myself and the parish to adjust to the change. I am now in my third year and the parish has become my home.

A big concern now, and definitely in the past, has been the financial needs of the parish. As pastor, I must choose what is best for St James. For this reason, and to try to increase our weekly plate income, changes are being made to our outreach program. We have changed how we receive Diocesan collections, and are planning changes to our E3 Africa outreach also.

We applaud the wonderful work done by E3 Africa in educating the needy children of Uganda. Since E3 Africa is a 501 C 3 organization, beginning July 1, 2018 we will continue our support of the program by committing to a \$100 monthly donation. Along with this change, the E3 Africa envelope will be removed from our envelope packets that the parishioners receive every two months. We are asking our parishioners to donate (sponsorship and/or development) directly to you. Some of our parishioners are involved directly with E3 Africa (board members, sponsors, etc) and some supporters will want to continue with their monthly contributions, but they must pay them directly to your organization. Since there is very little representation and involvement directly with the parish, E3.Africa does not truly function as a ministry of St James.

St James wishes E3 Africa the best in their continued growth and work in Northern Uganda! We are proud to have been part of the beginning of E3 Africa!
