WE ARE IN LENT.

As we begin the Lenten season by putting ashes on our foreheads, the gospel reminds us not to be satisfied with mere external symbols but to make it a real conversion of our heart. Practices of fasting, prayers, and charity, if devoid of proper motivation, will have no spiritual significance. They would be merely an exercise as self-serving as the Pharisees' acts to make a show and gain admiration. Jesus is not telling us to stop fasting, praying, or doing works of charity but to do them selflessly.

Other meaningful Lenten practices could be - having a kind word and listening compassionately to the lonely, praying for those who are suffering in body and spirit, helping to alleviate the misery of the poor, extending a helping hand to those in need, and being sensitive to the needs of the vulnerable, especially children and the elderly. The gospel tells us Jesus, after His baptism at the River Jordan, was filled with the Holy Spirit, went to the desert for forty days, and was tempted by the devil. Temptations are bound to come; even for Jesus there was no exemption. Jesus helps show us the way to face them.

One type of temptation comes from our nature to seek physical gratification. Freud calls it "the pleasure principle" which draws us towards seeking pleasure. Food and sex, which are basically meant for survival of the species, also have pleasure attached to them. Challenged with temptation to satisfy the bodily appetite, Jesus overcomes it with a commitment to fulfill his Father's will. He said to Satan, "It is not by food that man lives, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God". The pleasure of the body is represented by the world today as "the thing" to look for. Our hedonistic culture entertains no restraint on it. But even with the legitimate need, we need to discern whether it corresponds to our Father's will as Jesus did.

A second type of temptation is for fame and adulation. Jesus recognizes that the Father's will is not the path of stunning performance and receiving glory from people, but that of the cross which brings scoff and ridicule.

Third temptation is about finding happiness in possessions and power. Jesus is not really for worshipping any such idols of this world. When we live as if money, possessions, and power are the things that matter in life, we follow Satan's way than that of God.

Estamos en Cuaresma.

Cuando comenzamos la temporada de Cuaresma poniendo cenizas en nuestras frentes, el Evangelio nos recuerda que no estemos satisfechos con meros símbolos externos, sino que sea una conversión real de nuestro corazón. Las prácticas de ayuno, las oraciones y la caridad, si carecen de motivación adecuada, no tendrán ningún significado espiritual. Serían simplemente un ejercicio tan egoísta como los actos de los fariseos para hacer un espectáculo y ganar admiración. Jesús no nos está diciendo que dejemos de ayunar, orar o hacer obras de caridad, sino que las hagamos desinteresadamente.

Otras prácticas significativas de Cuaresma pueden ser: tener una palabra amable y escuchar con compasión a los que están solos, orar por aquellos que sufren en cuerpo y espíritu, ayudar a aliviar la miseria de los pobres, extender una mano de ayuda a los necesitados y ser sensible a las necesidades de los vulnerables, especialmente de los niños y ancianos. El evangelio nos dice que Jesús, después de su bautismo en el río Jordán, fue lleno del Espíritu Santo, estuvo en el desierto durante cuarenta días y fue tentado por el diablo. Las tentaciones están destinadas a venir; incluso para Jesús no había excepción. Jesús nos ayuda mostrándonos la manera de enfrentarlos.


Un tipo de tentación proviene de nuestra naturaleza para buscar la gratificación física. Freud lo llama "el principio del placer" que nos lleva a buscar placer. La comida y el sexo, que están básicamente destinados a la supervivencia de la especie, también tienen placer para ellos. Desafiado con la tentación de satisfacer el apetito corporal, Jesús lo supera con el compromiso de cumplir la voluntad de su Padre. Él le dijo a Satanás: "No es por la comida que vive el hombre, sino por cada palabra que sale de la boca de Dios". El placer del cuerpo está representado por el mundo de hoy como "la cosa" a buscar. Nuestra cultura hedonista no entretiene a nadie. Pero incluso con la necesidad legítima, debemos discernir si corresponde a la voluntad de nuestro Padre como lo hizo Jesús.

Un segundo tipo de tentación es la fama y la adulación. Jesús reconoce que la voluntad del Padre no es el camino de una actuación asombrosa y recibir la gloria de las personas, sino la de la cruz que trae burla y ridículo.

La tercera tentación es encontrar la felicidad en las posesiones y el poder. Jesús no es realmente para adorar a tales ídolos de este mundo. Cuando vivimos como si el dinero, las posesiones y el poder fueran las cosas que importan en la vida, seguimos el camino de Satanás más que el de Dios.






