As we prepare to introduce perpetual adoration at our parish one parishioner has drawn my attention to this excellent article which I intent to share with you over the next couple of weekends:

*Eucharistic Adoration provides us with a chance to be with our Savior one on one.*

*Through this practice, we are invited to spend time alone with God in his real, physical form and to bring to Jesus all our cares, concerns, prayers, hopes and thoughts. We set aside a special time, a respite from our hectic modern lives, to create a personal space in which to meet our God.*

The best kind of friend is the one with whom you can spend time without having to say anything. You can just share the moment and enjoy each other's company, knowing your relationship is deeper than the spoken word.

That kind of silent communication is what takes place between you and Jesus when you participate in Eucharistic Adoration.

Eucharistic Adoration is the spiritual practice of spending time in the presence of the exposed Host. One of the things that most identifies us as Catholics is our belief in the Eucharist as the Real Presence of Christ. Many Christian denominations have a service that commemorates the Last Supper, and quite a few distribute bread and wine (or [grape juice](#)) at that service.

*Adoración Eucarística nos proporciona con una oportunidad de estar con nuestro Salvador en persona. A través de esta práctica, somos invitados a pasar tiempo con Dios en Su verdadera presencia física y traer a Jesús a todas nuestras preocupaciones, problemas, esperanzas, oraciones, y pensamientos. Apartamos un tiempo especial, un Descanso de nuestras vidas modernas agitadas, para crear un espacio personal en cual encontrar a nuestro Dios.*

El mejor tipo de amigo es el cual uno puede pasar tiempo sin tener que decir nada. Pueden compartir el momento y gozar de su compañía, sabiendo que su relación is más profunda que la palabra dicha.

Esa clase de silencio es lo que sucede entre tú y Jesús cuando participas en Adoración Eucarística.

Adoración Eucarística es la práctica espiritual de pasar tiempo en la presencia de la Hostia. Una de las cosas que más nos identifica como Católicos es nuestra creencia en la Verdadera Presencia de Cristo. Muchas otras comunidades cristianas tienen servicios que conmemoraran la Ultima Cena, y bastantes distribuyan pan y vino (o jugo de uva) en ese servicio.

For Catholics, the Eucharist is no mere symbol of Jesus; we believe that the consecrated Host is actually the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ. It is the most profound way we experience the presence of Christ in our world today.

Receiving Communion at Mass is our best opportunity to fully experience Christ within our parish communities. We sit at the table of the Lord with our fellow believers and become one collective body as we share in Jesus's sacrifice in a tangible way.....

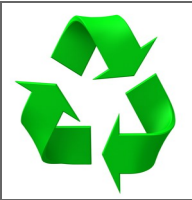

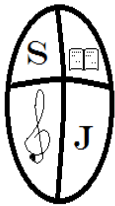

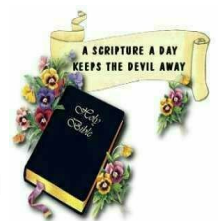
