

# **CHURCH AND CAMPUS RENEWAL**

We are excited to announce that we have met our initial goal of \$110,000 to renew our Church Environment. We would like to truly thank you for your support of the Church and Campus Renewal projects. The remodel project will begin with some pre-work in early February including the relocation of our gift shop and St Vincent de Paul entrance so that the remaining partitions can be removed. Major renovations will begin March 6<sup>th</sup> and are estimated to complete April 11<sup>th</sup>.

As we have prepared for the remodel, we have found some additional items such as larger drip pans for the air conditioning units, ceiling fans, and lighting that we feel need to be addressed prior to installation of pews while it's easier access to the ceiling area. We are in the process of getting estimated cost for these items and will utilize some of the savings from the original \$110,000 to cover these costs but we expect that we will need some additional funds. Therefore, we are asking that you continue your giving to the renewal fund through the end of March.
