G GOD ANSWERS OUR PRAYERS IN VERY UNLIKELY WAYS!

Sometimes we come to situations in our lives when we feel so lost, so abandoned and so hopeless; moments when we seek answers to our problems without seemingly getting answers. At times this is occasioned by one calamity befalling us after another. I suspect many of you, like me, can identify with this. But amidst all these, if we believe that our God is in control, He loves us and He will never let us down if we trust in Him, He will always see us through. This is better illustrated to me by a story I recently read from the internet entitled "The Little Hut". You might have read it yourselves already, however, let me nevertheless share it for the sake of those who have not read it.

According to this story, the only survivor of a shipwreck was washed up on a small, uninhabited island. He prayed feverishly for God to rescue him, and every day he scanned the horizon for help, but none seemed forthcoming. Exhausted, he eventually managed to build a little hut out of driftwood to protect himself from the elements, and to store his few possessions.

Then one day, after scavenging for food, he arrived home to find his little hut in flames, the smoke rolling up to the sky. The worst had happened – everything was lost. He was stunned with grief and anger. "God, how could you do this to me?" he cried.

Early the next day, however, he was awakened by the sound of a ship that was approaching the island. It had come to rescue him. "How did you know I was here?" asked the weary man of his rescuers. "We saw your smoke signal," they replied.

The moral of the story is that it's very easy to get discouraged sometimes when things appear to be going badly. In moments like these, we are tempted to despair. But we shouldn't lose heart, we shouldn't despair because God is always at work in our lives, even in the midst of pain, suffering and hopelessness.

Remember, next time your little hut is burning to the ground, it just may be a smoke signal that summons the grace of God. For all the negative things we have to say to ourselves, let us always remember that God has a positive answer for it.

St. James, are we really grateful for the many and abundant blessings that the Lord has gifted us with, even when things at times seemed grim? Are we grateful that the Lord has gotten us out of our debts, enabled us to re-model our Church, acquire pews, and have this wonderful community? Are we really grateful that He continues to provide for our spiritual and pastoral needs, continues to nourish us with the Holy Eucharist through our priests and many more? I am!

DIOS SIEMPRE NOS CONTESTA NUESTRAS ORACIONES HASTA EN MODOS INESPERADOS!

Hay veces que llegan a nuestras vidas situaciones cuando nos sentimos perdidos, muy abandonados y tan sin esperanza; momentos cuando buscamos las respuestas a nuestros problemas sin obtener solución. Hay veces que las calamidades nos caen una tras otra. Tengo sospecha que muchos de ustedes, como yo, podemos identificar con esto. Pero entre todo esto, si creemos que Dios está en control, que nos ama, que no nos dejará solos, el nos sacará adelante. Esto es mejor ilustrado por un cuento que leí en el internet recién titulada "El Cobertizo Chico". A lo mejor ustedes ya lo han leído, sin embargo, se los cuento en caso unos de ustedes no lo haya leído.

Según el cuento, el único sobreviviente de un naufragio llegó a una isla chica no poblada. Le rogó mucho a Dios que fuera salvado, y cada día veía hacia el horizonte por ayuda, pero no llegaba. Agotado, eventualmente armó un cobertizo de los pedazos del barco para protegerse de los elementos, y para guardar algunas posesiones.

Entonces un día, al llegar a su cobertizo lo encontró tragado en llamas de lumber. Lo peor había sucedido—había perdido lo poco que le quedaba. Desesperado y angustiado le gritó a Dios, "Dios, por qué has dejado que esto pasara?"

Temprano la próxima mañana, sin embargo, fue despertado por un sonido fuerte de barco que llegaba a la isla. Había venido a rescatarlo. "Cómo superaron que estaba aquí?" pregunto el hombre cansado a sus salvadores. "Vimos tu signo he humo," le respondieron.

El moral de la historia es que es fácil sentirnos desalentados cuando las cosas parecen no mejorar. En momentos como estos, tenemos la tentación de desesperación. Pero no deberíamos perder esperanza, no debemos sentir desesperación porque Dios siempre está obrando en nuestras vidas, hasta en medio del dolor, sufrimiento, y cuando no parece haber esperanza.

Acuérdese, la próxima vez que su cobertizo se esté quemando, solamente puede ser un signo que llama a la gracia de Dios. Para todas las cosas negativas que nos podemos decir a si mismos, acordemos que Dios tiene una respuesta positiva.

St. James, verdaderamente estamos muy agradecidos por las bendiciones abundantes que el Señor nos ha dado aún cuando las cosas andan mal? Estamos agradecidos que Dios nos ha sacado de deuda, y nos ha permitido remodeler la iglesia, obtener bancas, y tener esta bella comunidad? Realmente estamos agradecidos que El continua a proveer por nuestras necesidades espirituales y pastorales, que continúe nutriendonos que la Santa Eucaristía a traves de nuestros sacerdotes y mucho mas? Yo sí!

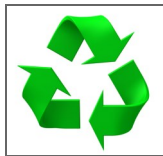

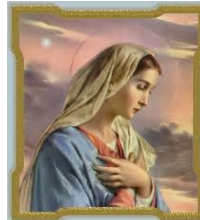
