



CHURCH AND CAMPUS RENEWAL

We are excited to announce that we have met our initial goal of \$110,000 to renew our Church Environment. We would like to truly thank you for your support of the Church and Campus Renewal projects. The remodel project will begin with some pre-work in early February including the relocation of our gift shop and St Vincent de Paul entrance so that the remaining partitions can be removed. Major renovations will begin March 6th and are estimated to complete April 11th.

As we have prepared for the remodel, we have found some additional items such as larger drip pans for the air conditioning units, ceiling fans, and lighting that we feel need to be addressed prior to installation of pews while it's easier access to the ceiling area. We are in the process of getting estimated cost for these items and will utilize some of the savings from the original \$110,000 to cover these costs but we expect that we will need some additional funds. Therefore, we are asking that you continue your giving to the renewal fund through the end of March.

Catechism of the Catholic Church

Paragraphs 85-86 The Magisterium of the Church

"The task of giving an authentic interpretation of the Word of God, whether in its written form or in the form of Tradition, has been entrusted to the living, teaching office of the Church alone. Its authority in this matter is exercised in the name of Jesus Christ." This means that the task of interpretation has been entrusted to the bishops in communion with the successor of Peter, the Bishop of Rome.

"Yet this Magisterium is not superior to the Word of God, but is its servant. It teaches only what has been handed on to it. At the divine command and with the help of the Holy Spirit, it listens to this devotedly, guards it with dedication, and expounds it faithfully. All that it proposes for belief as being divinely revealed is drawn from this single deposit of faith."


