

Pastor's Corner... Fr. Robert Aliunzi, A.J.

I CAN NOT THANK GOD ENOUGH FOR YOU, ST. JAMES!

This was followed a week later, by among others, the celebration of the Divine Mercy Sunday Mass (billed so far as the best), presided over by our dear Auxiliary Bishop Eduardo Nevares.

I would have loved to mention all of you by names but for practical reasons, I am imbedded but know that I am indebted to all of you. My committee will soon furnish you with accountability of what we have so far done and what remains to be accomplished in the next phases. In the meantime, continue to have a Blessed Easter.
