## Pastor's Corner... *Fr. Robert Aliunzi, A.J.*

### I WILL NOT LEAVE YOU ORPHANS!

"I will not leave you orphans...John 14:18." Having been orphaned at the age of six, these words of Our Lord resonate with me in a very particular way each time I read it. It always gives me the strength and joyful assurance that no matter what the world throws at me in life, I am not alone!

Early this year while I was at home in Uganda, I visited the orphanage in my home parish as I usually do. There are several orphanages in the country and most of them do a good job in taking care of the orphans. But I was always attracted to this particular one in my parish because of their mission statement which is – to establish a sustainable loving home for orphans, a home that can develop the children to reach their full potentials – that is – a place the orphans can call their home, a place they feel loved, a place they can feel cared for and a place they can grow and become the very best that they can be.

I was always very impressed by how the nuns cared for those kids most of who have either lost their parents to HIV/AIDS, or have been abandoned or given up for adoption maybe because their parents did not have the resources to care for them or for other reasons we may never know. I was impressed by how supportive they were to those kids and by their love for those orphans.

But whatever the care and the love, we can only imagine how it feels to be an orphan, to be without parents and to be without a place they can call their home except the orphanage. You only have to experience it like me and them to understand how it really feels.

Whenever we hear the story of an orphan, it is often a story of abandonment, a story of loneliness and a story of feeling unloved. Whenever we hear the story of an orphan it is a story of regrets and a story of insecurity. The chosen people said the same to Moses in the wilderness – did you bring us out here to die (Exodus 14:11)? A story of feeling of being abandoned!

There comes a time in our lives when the changes and the challenges of life can leave us feeling like orphans; and the questions are many - What will I do now? Where do I go from here? What happens next? Who will guide me? Who will stand by my side? What will become of me?

It is during those times that we all need to hear these words of Jesus again – I will not leave you orphans. These words speak directly to some of our greatest fears; they speak directly to our loneliness and they speak to our feeling of abandonment. They remind us that we are never ever alone even though sometimes it may seem so.

Jesus' assurance that He will not leave us orphans is not new in the Scripture. Throughout the history of salvation, God always assured the chosen people that He would never leave them alone – He said to them - I will be your God and you shall be my people (Jeremiah 30:22). He always assured them that even river or fire would never consume them because He the Holy One of Israel would be their Savior.

In Jeremiah the Lord makes this affirmation even more clear – I know well the plans I have for you, not a plan for your destruction but a plan to give you a future and a future full of hope. When you call on me and when you go to pray to me, I will answer you (Jeremiah 29:12). We hear a similar message in another passage - before I formed you in the womb I knew you, a prophet to the nations I appointed you...(Jeremiah 1:5). I have called you by name, you are mine (Isaiah 43). And of course, in the beloved Psalm 23 it is even more profound – even though I should walk through the valley of darkness, no evil shall I fear because I know the Lord is with me. I am never alone.

In the New Testament Jesus told His disciples the same before ascending to the Father – I will be with you always, yes, till the end of time.

Like the Apostles we all fear becoming orphans. And that fear points to the reality that we all need each other; that we are always better together. It points to the fact that we were never intended to stand alone. We were created to be in love and in relationships – to love and to be loved...at last a bone of my bone and a flesh of my flesh (Genesis 2:23).

I will not leave you orphan is a promise...a promise of Jesus to the Apostles and to each one of us. Regardless of the circumstances of our lives, the storms in life, or death, or separation, or abandonment, or loneliness – that promise still stands – I will not leave you orphans. God never leaves us alone.

St. James, if God never leaves us alone, we should also do our very best never to leave each other alone and in doing so we are keeping God's commandment – the commandment to love God and to love our neighbors as ourselves.



## Pastor's Corner... Fr. Robert Aliunzi, A.J.

### !NO LOS DEJARÉ HUERFANOS!

“No los dejaré huérfanos...Juan 14:18.” Por el hecho que yo quedé huérfano cuando tenía 6 años estas palabras siempre me impactan cada vez que las leo. Siempre me dan el aliento y fuerzas de saber que no importa lo que el mundo me echa encima, !no estoy solo!

Al comienzo del año cuando estuve en mi tierra, Uganda, visité un orfanato de mi parroquia como tengo acostumbrado. Hay varios ofanatos en el país y muchos de ellos cuidan muy bien a los huérfanos. Pero éste en particular me gusta por su declaración de misión—establecer un hogar sostenible para huérfanos, un hogar donde cada niño puede alcanzar su potencial—es decir---un lugar que los huérfanos pueden llamar su hogar, un lugar donde se sienten amados, un lugar donde se sienten cuidados, y un lugar donde pueden crecer y ser lo mejor que pueden ser.

Siempre me ha impresionado como las monjas cuidan a esos niños muchos quienes cuyos padres han morido de SIDA, o han sido abandonados , o dados para adopción posiblemente porque los padres no tenían los recursos necesarios o por otras razones las cuales nunca se sabrán. Me impresionó el amor que les muestran a esos niños y el apoyo que les aportan.

Pero siembargo del amor y cuidado que reciben, es difícil imaginarse ser huérfano, como se siente no tener padres y sin lugar que pueden llamar hogar excepto el orfanato. Es algo que se tiene que experimentar como yo y esos huérfanos para realmente entender como se siente.

Cada vez que oímos una historia de un huérfano, casi siempre es una historia de abandono, una historia de soledad, y una historia de sentirse no amado. Cuando oímos la historia de un huérfano es una historia de arrepentimiento e inseguridad. Los Hebreos también semejantemente se quejaron con Moisés en el desierto---¿nos trajiste al desierto para morir? (Éxodo 14:11) Una historia del sentido de abandono.

Llega un momento en nuestras vidas cuando los cambios y desafíos en nuestras vidas nos hacen sentir como huérfanos; y las preguntas son muchas--¿Ahora que haré? ¿Qué camino tomaré? ¿Qué va a pasar? ¿Quién me dará guía? ¿Quién estará a mi lado? ¿Qué será de mí?

Es durante esas rachas que todos necesitamos oír nuevamente las palabras de Jesús---no los dejaré huérfanos. Estas palabras nos llegan a nuestros grandes temores; hablan directamente a nuestra soledad, y hablan a nuestro sentido de abandono. Nos hacen recordar que realmente nunca estamos solos aunque hay veces que así nos sentimos.

La aseguanza de Jesús que no nos dejará huérfanos no es algo nuevo en las Escrituras. A través la historia salvífica, Dios siempre aseguró a los Hebreos que Él nunca los abandonaría—Él les dijo---Yo seré su Dios y ustedes serán mi pueblo (Jeremías 30:22) Él siempre les aseguró que ni el río ni el fuego los consumiría porque Él el Dios de Israel sería su Salvador.

En Jeremías Dios más claramente afirma esto---Yo sé bien los planes que te tengo, no un plan para tú derrota, sino un plan para darte un futuro y un futuro lleno de esperanza. Cuándo me llares y cuando rezes a mí, yo te contestaré (Jeremías 29:12). Oímos otros mensaje semejante en otro paisaje----antes de formarte en el seno materno, te conozco; antes de que nacieras, te consagré profeta para las naciones....(Jeremías 1:5). Te he llamado por nombre, tú me perteneces (Isaías 43). Y claro, el muy amado versículo Salmo 23---Aun si voy por valles tenebrosos, no temo peligro alguno porque tú estás a mi lado; tu vara de pastor me reconforta. Nunca estoy solo.

En el Nuevo Testamento Jesús les dijo a sus discípulos la misma cosa antes de ascender al Padre---siempre estaré con ustedes, sí, hasta el fin del tiempo.

Como los ápostoles, todos tememos quedar huérfanos. Y ese miedo signa a la realidad que todos nos necesitamos, uno al otro; que siempre estamos mejor juntos. Signa al hecho que no simos creados para estar solos. Fuímos creados para estar en amor y en relaciones---para amar y ser amados.....ésta es ahora hueso de mis huesos, y carne de mi carne (Génesis 2:23).

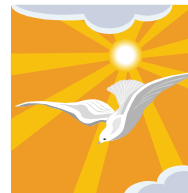
