WHAT OPPORTUNITIES DOES THE MONTH OF OCTOBER HOLD FOR US?

The month of October is fast coming to its conclusion, never to return with the same challenges and opportunities it has offered us today. For the last two weekends of this month, our focus has been largely on adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. We have in different ways underscored the centrality of the Eucharist in our lives as Catholics who believe in the real presence of our Lord in the Eucharist. It is for that reason and also to encourage greater participation in this noble devotion that we have decided to add one more day on Mondays from 5.00pm to 8.30pm. It is an opportunity I call upon each one of you to embrace to be with the Lord at least for an hour a week!

October is also a month that each year, the bishops of the United States dedicate as Respect Life month and invite all of us Catholics to pray, reflect and renew our commitment to the defense of human life from conception to natural death. Yes, the fundamental principle of our faith rooted in the Holy Scriptures stresses the dignity and worth of each human person. So what are we called to do then, this month and always? This is what Pope John Paul II, in his message 'The Gospel of Life' calls us to do when he says: "What is urgently called for is a...united ethical effort to activate a campaign in support of life". Recognizing that human life is our first gift from God, this call is therefore, a challenge that demands a response from each one of us to protect and defend it. **We have an opportunity the coming weekend Sunday, October 26, to participate in this campaign through our annual pro-life rally after the 11.00AM Mass beginning at 12.30PM.** I invite you to please, come join me and be a part of this great opportunity to make this rally a success. Kevin Saunders, a remarkable biblical scholar will be our key note speaker.

On a different note, I would like to let you know that on **Saturday November 1, I am calling upon each of you to come and join me from 9.00AM to 11.00AM, in giving our parish a new physical look.** On that day we are going to do a general clean-up of our grounds removing weeds and trimming our trees. I therefore, invite you to put that on your busy calendars and come with gloves, shovels, pruners, trimmers, hedge trimmers, blowers, saws, mowers....and any yard equipment to "Renew our Parish Look". I will send you reminders as the day approaches. Have a blessed week.

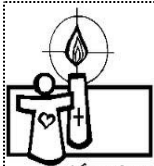

Biblical Basis for Life at Conception

Presented in the Hall from 1 pm to 2:30 pm

The noted biblical scholar and lecturer, Kevin Saunders, will present a talk on the biblical basis for the position that the existence of human life begins at conception. That existence coupled with the American "Constitutional" guarantee of life as a right, would seem to make abortion at any stage of development constitutionally illegal.
