Is there a family you know who needs assistance? Please call SVdP so that together we can be a sign of God's love to the suffering and poor.

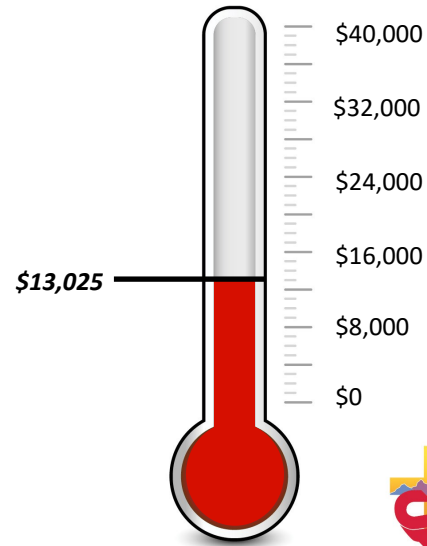
This week our pantry needs soup, canned corn and peanut butter.

One of the pillars of Lent is almsgiving. As difficult as this past year has been for many of us, God calls us to pull out of ourselves, our own difficulties and remember “whatever you did for one of these least brothers of mine, you did for me.” (Matt 25:40) Our Parish will be collecting specific items that Andre House has requested so these needs can be met.

Andre House, a ministry run by Holy Cross priests focuses on serving the homeless by providing showers, laundry, lockers, clothing and about 600 dinners 6 nights a week. They also have a limited number of transitional shelter beds for men & women.

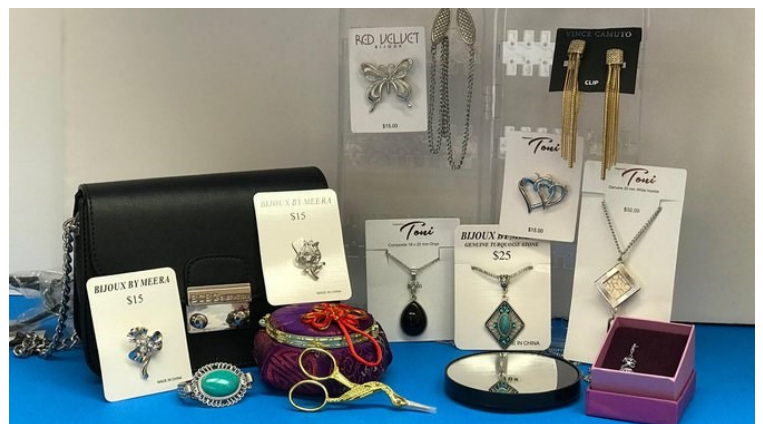
