

CHRIST LIGHT SHINES IN DARKNESS.

Christmas celebrates God's becoming incarnate in time and history. The God who promised to be among us has come and continues to be with us, now and always, through Jesus and the Holy Spirit. As the shortest days of the year end, and the light of a new year begins, we celebrate Christ's presence with us to transform our world. The darkness of sin and reign of evil confronts us each day in the form of wars, extrajudicial killing in many parts of the world, theft, infidelity, corruption, poverty etc. All of these must now be confronted by the light of all nations and the reign of God.

Where Christ light is allowed to shine, the dark shadows of sin will be illuminated, allowing us to live in the light. So, each day, as the light intensifies, we proclaim that "Christ light shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it" (Jn 1:5).

Like John the Baptist we too are called, "to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him" (Jn 1:7). Our testimony to Christ's light will be evident in our words and in our actions. As we are more and more enlightened by Christ, we become beacons of hope for others in a world still steeped in darkness.

Our life at Christmas is miniature. We are invited to let God enlighten us so that we become children of God or persons that are full of gift of the divine life and its power to change us. In Jesus, God the Father makes an appeal to all humanity to enter into this new life and live in God's light.






