

Are you a Trained Medical Professional Who Could Assist in an Emergency?

In an ongoing effort to make St. James a safe and welcoming community, we have decided to compile a list of all medical folks who attend St. James. This list will assist the security team in the event of a medical emergency. A part of our parishioners, are getting older and we want to make sure we can assist them if they need us. As we all know accidents do happen.

Phoenix Fire will be called if something happens, but we need to account for a response time.

So, if you wish to be on the list just stop by the office and leave your name, medical profession and the mass you normally attend. When you come Mass just let the hospitality person with the radio earpiece you are there. Thank you for assisting in this ministry to keep everybody safe here at St. James.

The Safety Team has been working hard to keep everybody safe for almost a year now. As time goes on it has become very clear we need more volunteers. The current volunteers are working almost every weekend and they need a break.

We need at least 10 more volunteers to staff this ministry properly. Please consider volunteering. It involves working an additional hour on either Saturday evening or Sunday morning/evening.

The mass you work is not the mass you attend.

"The tasks are not involved and are in a written procedure so you know what is involved." Essentially you need to observe and report. Some contact with the public, saying hello, smiling or asking a few questions if the person seems out of place, and checking some doors.

Liturgical Ministry

We first want to tell you about the Liturgical Ministry which offers many opportunities for parishioners to assist with presenting a spiritual, organized, and elegant liturgical services. Participation demonstrates one's commitment to faith and enhances that faith which supports the body of Christ - our community of St. James. Contact the Parish office for any of the Ministries below.

Altar Servers

Children, teens, or adults assist the Priest and the Deacon during Mass or other liturgical functions held throughout the year, including Benediction following Adoration. Being an Altar Server means serving God and His people during Mass. As an Altar Server, what you do on the alter and how you do it, can help other people to better understand the Mass. Altar Servers also assist the Mass Coordinator with setting up and taking down items used for the Mass. Completion of the Sacraments is required. Attendance at monthly training meetings is expected.

Art & Environment

Creative talent is appreciated when decorating the worship space for the specific seasons of the Church's Liturgical Calendar. Altar linens and vestment care are also a part of this ministry requiring sewing, laundering, and ironing. The Art & Environment ministers provide a worship space that appears sacred, attractive and is conducive to spending time with the Lord.

Training for New Lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of The Eucharist (EMs) and Ministers of Hospitality will take place in the Church this Monday, June 26th, starting at 6:00PM

Lectors

Children, teens, or adults with a love of leading and an interest in public speaking may proclaim the Word of God at Mass and other liturgical celebrations. Training is provided.

Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist

Teens age 16 or older & adults can assist the celebrant distribute the Sacred Body of Christ to the community during Mass. Ministers also assist with the clean up after Mass. Training is provided.

Ministers of Hospitality

Teens or adults greet parishioners and guests with welcoming smiles, assist with seating, collect the offering, and distribute the weekly bulletin at the end of Mass. Hospitality ministers assist those who are disabled or anyone needing extra assistance. Training is provided.

Music Ministry
