In an ongoing effort to make St. James a safe and welcoming community, we have decided to compile a list of all medical folks who attend St. James. This list will assist the security team in the event of a medical emergency. A part of our parishioners, are getting older and we want to make sure we can assist them if they need us. As we all know accidents do happen. Phoenix Fire will be called if something happens, but we need to account for a response time. So, if you wish to be on the list just stop by the office and leave your name, medical profession and the mass you normally attend. When you come Mass just let the hospitality person with the radio earpiece you are there. Thank you for assisting in this ministry to keep everybody safe here at St. James.

Family Formation

The Family Formation program meets once per month. Catechists meet a second time during the month for training.

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW)

Children's Liturgy of the Word is held during the 11:00 AM and the 1:00 PM Masses. The children leave the Mass just before the sermon to have Catechists review the readings of the day and their application to today's world. The children return to the Mass before the Consecration.

EDGE Junior High Group

The Junior High Group meets for formation and fellowship twice per month. EDGE is a Catholic middle school youth ministry program. It provides a safe and fun environment for youth to find a solid Catholic community, to receive answers to questions about their faith and to experience Jesus in a profound and personal way.

The Senior High Youth Group is a Christ Centered program to give our youth the choice of a counterculture to be part of.
