Are you a Trained Medical Professional Who Could Assist in an Emergency?

In an ongoing effort to make St. James a safe and welcoming community, we have decided to compile a list of all medical folks who attend St. James. This list will assist the security team in the event of a medical emergency. A part of our parishioners, are getting older and we want to make sure we can assist them if they need us. As we all know accidents do happen. Phoenix Fire will be called if something happens, but we need to account for a response time. So, if you wish to be on the list just stop by the office and leave your name, medical profession and the mass you normally attend. When you come Mass just let the hospitality person with the radio earpiece you are there. Thank you for assisting in this ministry to keep everybody safe here at St. James.

EDGE Junior High Group

The Junior High Group meets for formation and fellowship twice per month. EDGE is a Catholic middle school youth ministry program. EDGE High School Group

The Senior High Youth Group is a Christ Centered program to give our youth the choice of a counterculture to be part of. Specifically, one that is wholesome, Catholic, free from the wickedness and of the devil. Members eat meals together, play together & have riveting discussions and debates. There are retreats where participants learn how to pray and about the love and mercy God has for us.

Quinceañeras

This is celebration of a young woman turning 15 by members of our Spanish Community. There is a 6 week class required to prepare young women to have strong Catholic Christian values, pride in themselves, and to thank God for all the gifts he has given them. These are then celebrated in a religious ceremony. Family Membership in St. James is required.

RCIA

Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults & Teens is a time for learning the basic tenets of the Catholic faith. These classes are offered to those interested in joining the Catholic church.

Current or returning Catholics interested in updating their understanding of the Catholic faith will also benefit from the RCIA program.
