



This path is now accessible for anyone who has difficulty walking, or somebody who uses a walker or any other device to aid them. It will also be easier for people to walk with regular shoes.

So, check it out. There will be a slide on the tv in the foyer of the path so you may see it that way also.

**Are you a Trained Medical Professional
Who Could Assist in an Emergency?**

In an ongoing effort to make St. James a safe and welcoming community, we have decided to compile a list of all medical folks who attend St. James. This list will assist the security team in the event of a medical emergency.

A part of our parishioners, are getting older and we want to make sure we can assist them if they need us. As we all know accidents do happen.

Phoenix Fire will be called if something happens, but we need to account for a response time.

So, if you wish to be on the list just stop by the office and leave your name, medical profession and the mass you normally attend. When you come to Mass just let the hospitality person with the radio earpiece know you are there.

Thank you for assisting in this ministry to keep everybody safe here at St. James.

ST. JAMES PARISH 2023 ADVENT SERVICE PROJECT CATHOLIC CHARITIES' REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT PROGRAM

Background:

Annually your Pastoral Council sponsors a Service Project during the Advent Season. This year it was approached by Sister Betty, who works for Catholic Charities in the Refugee Resettlement Program, asking if we could collect needed items for them to distribute to the many refugees they resettle. The Council decided this would be an ideal Advent Service Project for this year.

Program Information:
