

Are you a Trained Medical Professional Who Could Assist in an Emergency?

In an ongoing effort to make St. James a safe and welcoming community, we have decided to compile a list of all medical folks who attend St. James. This list will assist the security team in the event of a medical emergency. A part of our parishioners, are getting older and we want to make sure we can assist them if they need us. As we all know accidents do happen.

Phoenix Fire will be called if something happens, but we need to account for a response time.

So, if you wish to be on the list just stop by the office and leave your name, medical profession and the mass you normally attend. When you come to Mass just let the hospitality person with the radio earpiece know you are there.

Thank you for assisting in this ministry to keep everybody safe here at St. James.

The Safety Team has been working hard to keep everybody safe for a year now. As time goes on it has become very clear we need more volunteers. The current volunteers are working almost every weekend and they need a break.

We need at least 10 more volunteers to staff this ministry properly. Please consider volunteering. It involves working an additional hour on either Saturday evening or Sunday morning/evening.

The mass you work is not the mass you attend.
"The tasks are not involved and are in a written procedure so you know what is involved." Essentially you need to observe and report. Some contact with the public, saying hello, smiling or asking a few questions if the person seems out of place, and checking some doors.

For those new to St. James and Adobe, every year at Thanks-St. James completes the kid's Thanksgiving Dinner by providing Dessert for them.




