

Introducing St. Joseph's Youth Camp - an AZ Summer Camp!

Originally founded as a Knights of Columbus camp, SJYC is now a nonprofit organization that has retained our strong ties to the Arizona Catholic community. This summer is our 75th, and we are so excited to build more incredible memories around the campfire in only a short couple of months.

Ages 7 to 15: Campers register for a 7-day, 6-night getaway (transportation is provided to and from Phoenix to camp and back). During their week away, campers will meet others their age, participate in plenty of fun, outdoor activities, and make memories they will be talking about all year long! Activities include arts & crafts, horseback riding, archery, hiking, kayaking, campfire & s'mores, capture the flag, ziplining/high rope courses (Teen Week only), astronomy, and much more! We also offer a Catholic Week (June 16 - 22) that will allow children ages 7 to 12 to participate in Mass, Catechism, Bible studies, and making a rosary in addition to the other fun activities. Ages 15 to 17: Counselors in Training (CITs) register for a week-long training, where they will go through First Aid/CPR/AED certification and child safety training and have the opportunity to earn community service hours. Additionally, they will partake in personal development activities and discussions aimed to give them skills in communication, leadership, greater good, positivity, and inclusion. With these skills, they will be ready to be a leader both at camp and in their day-to-day lives. If selected, counselors in training will be invited to return as volunteer counselors to put their skills into action (and earn 96 community service hours). This is a great opportunity for teens looking to grow in their leadership and mentorship, earn community service hours, and build strong experiences for college applications! Learn more here. 
