

One woman said that she had lived close by St James "for over 8 years", she had attended the Fish Fry Friday's this year "for the first time" and brought friends or family along for most of the remaining Fridays. She had really enjoyed getting to meet and speak with people at the same table and is sad that Lent only lasts for a few weeks. She had never known about the Fish Fry's until the February sale, despite driving past the church daily.

Another woman let us know that she had been the recipient of a Christmas basket from St James. She wanted to let us know that her family was doing well and the basket had meant a lot, especially to her kids. She wanted to know how she could drop off items.

We also had three new volunteers - three young men whose family has received help from St. Vincent de Paul. They helped us with tear down and the loading of the truck for SVDP on Saturday for 4 hours at least.


