This **May 25th and 26th**, Sister Socorro Pineda of the Carmelite Missionary Sisters of St. Teresa of the Child Jesus of Puebla Mexico will be selling religious items to raise funds, to support their mission projects in The Sierra Norte of Puebla Mexico. A place of mission with indigenous people for 80 years, where many indigenous people have known God. In this place, we are supporting the native children to receive catechism, a retreat house for all who need it, a mission for the poorest of the poor to receive the most basic medical services, and to provide education to people who cannot read.
