

We now have an evacuation path outside the courtyard gate. This path is now accessible for anyone who has difficulty walking, or somebody who uses a walker or any other device to aid them. It will also be easier for people to walk with Regular shoes. Check it out. There will be a slide on the tv in the foyer of the path so you may see it that way also.

Children will not be allowed to go to the bathroom by themselves. Small children and young teens need to be supervised, in case of an emergency, Security will be busy securing doors or evacuating people.






