
Mission Statement

Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without honor except in his native place and among his own kin and in his own house." Join us for ongoing catechesis, volunteering in Parish events and fun. (Adult catechist volunteers needed.




Preparation classes for:

First Reconciliation



Students in their second year of Family Formation program AND in at least the 2nd grade. Meets Wednesdays from September to January, except the first Wednesday.





For students in their third year of Family Formation program AND in at least 3rd grade. Meets most Wednesdays of the month except the first, from January to May. Sacraments received in May.

For students in their second or third year of Formation, (depending on age of whenstarting formation—approval must be received prior to registering for this program) Prior formation received can be a combination of Family Formation, EDGE and Teen Group. Students must be in at least 7th thru 12th grade.

Meets most Sundays from 4:45pm to 5:45pm from Sept. 10th to March 17th. Sacraments received at Easter Vigil.






